Bux-Mont Championship Football Team

1960

The following narrative was published in the Class of 1961 "Antler" Yearbook

Driving to their first championship since 1934, the mighty CB football team coached by Mr. John Maskas* Mr. James Egloff, and Mr. Richard Smith, overpowered opponent after opponent. In addition to a final league record of 7-1-1, the Bucs also managed to win over Bensalem in a non-league game. Co-captains Hawthorne Duckett* and Joe Arcade led the team through the victorious season, at the same time, winning numerous honors for themselves, A hard fighting Hatboro team outclassed the Bucs and marched to a 20-7 victory, while Pennridge managed a 20-20 tie earlier in the season. These two games marked the only times all season that the Bucs ailed to outscore their opponents. Duckett, leading ground-gainer of the team with 1,359 yards gained, was named all Bux-Mont, All Scholastic Team for the Philadelphia area, and second team All Pennsylvania. Arcade joined his teammate on the All Bux-Mont and All individual scoring with 134 points and a yards per-carry percentage of 8.76. Guard Roger Saillant was selected to a second team. All Bux-Mont, while Jay Barlow, Carl Reiben, Joe Kosak, John Fonash, and Rudy Rudisill all received Honorable Mention.
