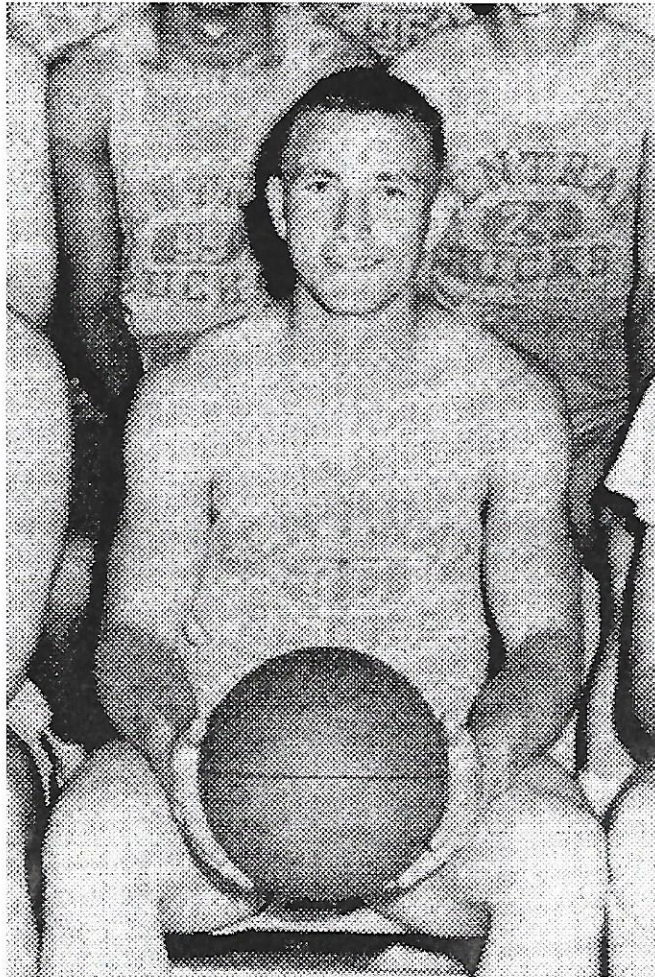

Donald "Ducky" Peters
Central Bucks High School -- 1955

During his athletic career at Central Bucks High School, Donald "Ducky" Peters earned 6 Varsity letters—3 in Football and 3 in Baseball.

Football

As Captain, in his Senior year Ducky was selected to 1st Team All Bux-Mont Intelligencer and High School All-American on Defense. He scored 11 touchdowns and as Linebacker, logged 83 tackles. His punting average was 34-1/2 yards.

Baseball

Ducky played Varsity each of his three years of high school, taking the field at 2nd Base and also in Right Field.

He was accepted to the Naval Academy at Annapolis. After his graduation Ducky served 8 years active duty with the United States Navy. He served on the USS Wallace L. Lind -- DD703 as a Supply Officer, spending some of his service in Europe. It was while still in the Navy that he met his wife Cass. After his discharge he was employed by various companies in Connecticut, Maine, Massachusetts and Philadelphia, holding management positions as either General Manager or Vice-President.

Ducky and Cass raised three children—Scott, Glenn and Jillian. In 2006 they retired to Florida settling in Wesley Chapel where they could be close to their grandchildren.

When he learned that he was selected to the Hall of Fame, Ducky was truly surprised and pleased, thanking everyone who supported him.
