J.J. Kelso earned seven letters for his participation in Football, Baseball and Basketball. He was a member of the undefeated 1985 Bux-Mont Champion Football team and the undefeated 1986 and 1987 Suburban One League National Conference Champion Football teams, all of which were nationally ranked by USA Today. In his Senior year, J.J. was awarded the Master of Sports Award for earning those seven Varsity letters in three different sports.

Baseball.

J.J. earned three letters for his participation in Baseball, playing the positions of First Baseman and Pitcher. In 1988 he was voted Captain and Team MVP. That same year J.J. was selected to play on the Suburban One National Conference All-Star Team. Known as the Carpenter Cup Baseball Classic, his team won the 1988 tournament.

Playing the positions of Fullback/Linebacker, J.J. earned Varsity letters each of his three years on the squad as the team compiled a record of 32-0. His teammates voted him Co-Captain of the North Squad for the 1988 Bucks County Lions High School All-Star Football Game. That same year, as a Senior, he received the Atkinson-Barness Merit Award for Outstanding Citizenship, Scholarship and Athletic Achievement and the C.B. West Football Mother's Club Scholarship Award.

J.J. entered the University of Delaware in Newark where he played two years of football before injuries ended his career.

Upon earning a Bachelor of Arts Degree in Mathematics and Foreign Language & Literature, he accepted a position with CKS Engineers, Inc. located in Doylestown. For the past 21 years he has served as a Construction Manager/Draftsman/Code Enforcement Officer.

J.J. and his wife Laurie-- also a C.B. West graduate--live in Doylestown and have three active children. Molly and Georgia are 10 year-old twins and Graham is 9. J.J. enjoys playing golf and coaching his children's football, baseball, basketball, soccer and softball teams.
