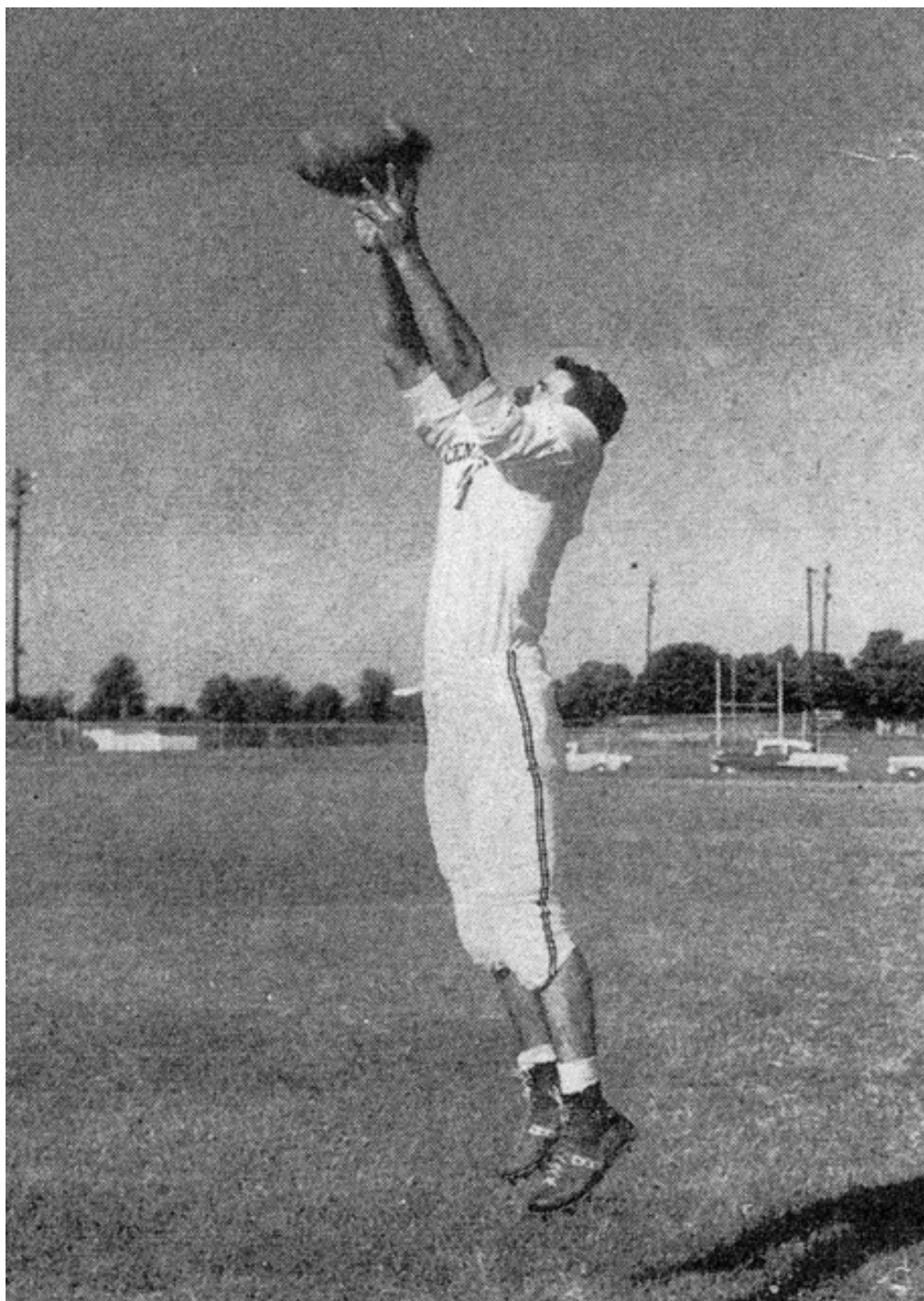

**Joe Arcade -- 1961
Central Bucks High School**

Joe Arcade played in three sports at Central Bucks High School, receiving Varsity letters in each: Football, Basketball and Track.

Football

Joe competed in the positions of Offensive and Defensive End in his three years on the Varsity Squad. His awards in Football led to a full Football Scholarship to Syracuse University.

- In 1959 received Honorable Mention, All Bux-Mont.
- In 1960 as Co-Captain in his Senior year when the team won the League Championship.
- Selected to First Team of All Bux-Mont and to the Delaware Valley All Scholastic Team.
- Received Outstanding Lineman and Booster Club Most Valuable Player.
- 1961 Co-Male Athlete of the year.

Basketball

In his Junior and Senior years, Joe played Forward on the Varsity squad.

Track

Joe earned Varsity letters in his three years, competing in the 100 and 220 Yard Dash, the one-Mile Relay and the Broad Jump.

At Syracuse University for four years, Joe played Center Guard on the Varsity Football team. After graduation he was employed with the Defense Intelligence Agency (DIA) in Washington, DC. Drafted in the United States Army, Joe served for one year in Vietnam.

Upon his return to civilian life, he married Ricky whom he had met while at Syracuse University. Eventually they settled in Greenwich, Connecticut where Joe was employed in his father-in-law's business until he retired in 1997. He and Ricky have one son Jonah who lives in Brooklyn with his wife Samantha and their two daughters Tirzah and Delaney.
