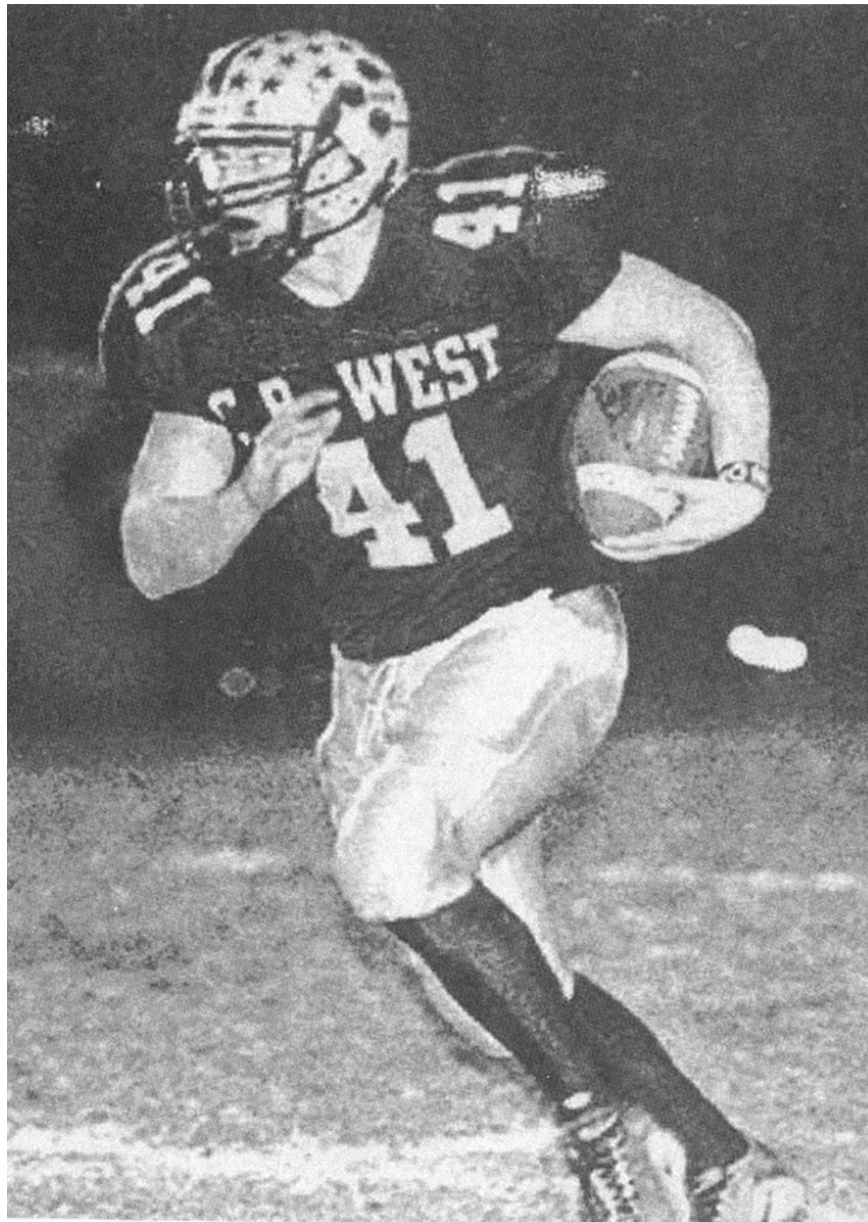

**Dave Camburn  
Central Bucks West -- 2001**

Dave Camburn earned 6 Varsity Letters at Central Bucks West -- 3 in Football and 3 in Wrestling. He received the Stanley McFarlane Most Outstanding Athlete Award in his Senior year.

## **Football**

Dave was a member of the Varsity Squad each of his three years in high school, playing on the Team's 1998 and 1999 State Championship Teams and the 2000 State Runner Up Team. His flexibility on the field saw him at the positions of Safety, Running Back, and Special Teams. Selected Team Captain in his Senior Year, Dave was voted the Bucks Club's Most Valuable Player. Additional selections include:

- Junior and Senior years 1st Team All Intelligencer.
- Senior Year 1st Team All Suburban I as All Purpose Back and Defensive Back.
- Senior year 1st Team All Area Montgomery County.
- Senior year 1st Team AP All State Defensive Back.
- Senior year Most Valuable Player Bucks County All Star Game.
- Senior year Big 33 Nominee.

## **Wrestling**

Dave was selected Rookie of the Year as a Sophomore on the varsity wrestling team. He competed in two individual weight classes: 160 lb and 171 lb. Each of the 3 years on the squad earned him a Varsity Letter and led to him competing at the PIAA State Championships during his Junior and Senior years.

Additional recognitions:

- 1st Team All Intelligencer Junior and Senior years.
- Most Valuable Wrestler at 160 lb Class as a Junior and 171 lb Class as a Senior.
- Sectional Champion -- 171 lb Class, Senior year.
- District Champion -- 171 lb Class, Senior year.
- In Senior year placed 7th in 171 lb Class at the PIAA State Championships.
- In Senior year won Pennsylvania vs New Jersey All Star Dual Match.
- Earned All State at 171 lbs weight in his Senior year.

Dave received a Football Scholarship to the University of Delaware in Newark. Starting as a true freshman, he earned 4 varsity letters. In 2003 the Blue Hens Touchdown Club named him Defensive Player of the Week against a game with Navy. In that same season Dave was a starter on the NCAA National Championship Football Team. Rugby became his chosen second sport at Delaware in which he competed for three seasons. He played four seasons with the Doylestown High School Rugby Team earning the Eastern Pennsylvania Rugby Union MVP during his high school senior year.

Dave and wife Kelly (a 1,000 point basketball scorer at The Hill School and Division I player at Drexel) live in Doylestown with their three children, Xavier (6), Reagan (4), and Kennedy (1).
