Jeannine Sweeney (Duffy) was a three-sport athlete who received 6 Varsity letters during her Central Bucks West Athletic career: Field Hockey, Basketball and Softball.

Field Hockey

She was the starting Right Midfielder for the 1988 and 1989 Undefeated Suburban One League Champion Field Hockey teams. Jeannine was selected and competed as a member of the 1989 USA Junior Olympic Field Hockey Team.

- 2 years as Varsity starter and letter recipient
- Team was SOL Champions in 1988 & Undefeated SOL Champs in 1989
- Overall record during her playing seasons with the team was 28-5-5
- In her Varsity career she tallied 3 goals and 10 assists
- In 1988 was voted 2nd Team, Suburban One League
- Awarded the Most Improved Player Award in 1988
- In 1989 was again voted 2nd Team, Suburban One League
- Voted to the All-Intelligencer Area 2nd Team as a senior
- Selected for the 1989 USA Junior Olympic Games held in San Antonio, Texas

Basketball

In her two years on the Varsity Basketball team, Jeannine was a Shooting Guard who was often given the role of defending the opponent's most dangerous player. As a Junior, she was the 6th man on the 1989 SOL Championship team.

Softball

During her years on the CBW Softball team, Jeannine batted second and anchored the outfield in Center Field. She helped propel the team to a Suburban One League Championship in 1990 and served as a Team Captain.

- She maintained a .550 OB%, a .386 BA, stole 31 bases and scored 42 runs in her 2year Varsity career

- Suburban One League Co-Championship team in 1990
- Voted by league coaches to 1st Team all SOL in 1990

CB West presented Jeannine with the United States Marine Corps Distinguished Athlete Award for displaying courage, poise, self-confidence and leadership as a high school athlete and the Master of Sports Award for athletes who are 3-sport letter winners. Jeannine attended St. Joseph's University, graduating in 1994. There she played both D1 Field Hockey and Softball all 4 years. She captained both teams in her senior seasons. Recognitions included:
