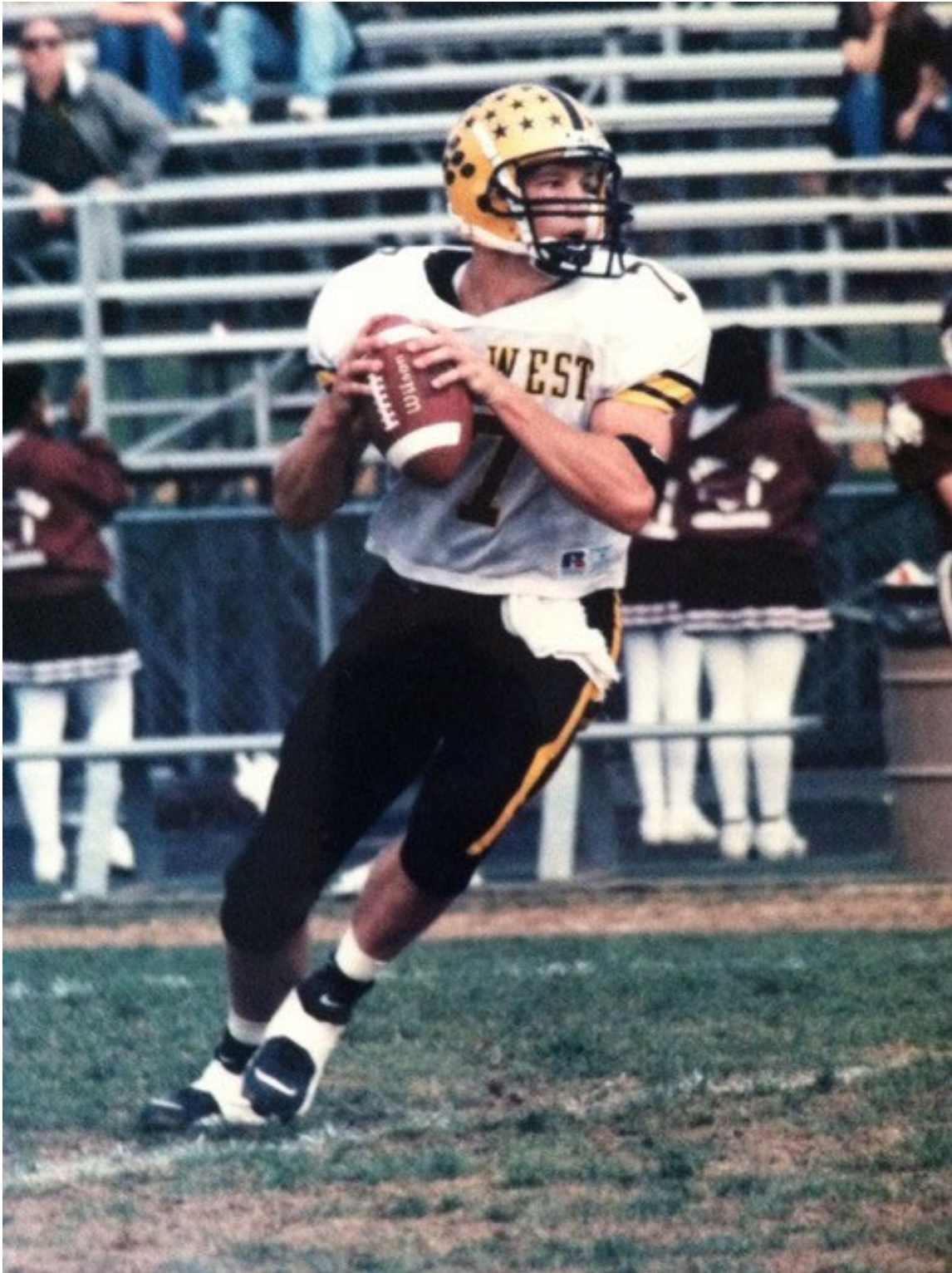

Coming out of High School, Travis was part of the #1 Nationally Ranked Recruiting class of 1997 at Penn State. As a Freshmen he started on the Special Teams Unit and saw spot duty at Defensive Back. After struggling through the 1998 season with multiple injuries and a position change, Travis transferred to the University of Delaware and started at Defensive Back. A shoulder and knee injury ultimately ended his career. Travis finished his education

graduating from West Chester University with a Bachelor's of Science Degree and Minor in Health & Athletic Coaching.

Travis pursued a career in law enforcement and obtained a Top-Secret clearance with the US government. He graduated top of his class at the Academy and received the Tactical Excellence Award. He served 10 years as an Officer and Sergeant with the United States Federal Government.

With a young family, Travis left his career in law enforcement to coach and train athletes. He coached football at West Chester University finishing the season ranked #4 in the nation. Following his stint at WCU, Coach Blomgren was hired as the Defensive Coordinator and Head Strength & Conditioning Coach at William Tennent High School in Warminster, Pennsylvania.

Currently Travis owns and operates Blomgren Training Systems, mentoring and training local athletes in all sports ranging from the youth level up to the collegiate level in Strength & Conditioning and Sport Performance.

Travis lives in Perkasio, Pennsylvania with his wife Jordan and their four children—Brody, Sawyer, Easton & Colton.
