Lauri McCandless was a double Varsity letter winner at Central Bucks West, in Field Hockey for three years and Soccer for four years

Field Hockey

Lauri's played her Sophomore and Junior years at Right Defense, then moved to Right Middle in her Senior year. The team went on to win League Championships in Lauri's last two years and was selected All-League First Team.

Soccer

During each of her four years of Varsity Soccer, Lauri competed on the field where needed, most times as a Sweeper and Center Mid Forward. She was selected as All-League First Team three years in a row. Lauri was a member of the Eastern Pennsylvania Youth Soccer Association for the age 16 (EPYSAU-16) State Select Team.

- Team Captain and MVP, 1990 and 1991
- 40 career goals and 27 career assists

In recognition of her sports accomplishments, Lauri received the Central Bucks West Female Athlete of the Year Award and the Stanley H. McFarland Outstanding Athlete Award.

Lauri attended LaSalle University from 1992-1996, and was recruited as a Forward on a 4-year Soccer Scholarship. In her Freshman year she competed as a Freshman Sweeper, a Stopper in her Sophomore and Junior years, and as a Center Mid-Fielder or Forward in her Senior year. In her Freshman year she made the Conference All-Rookie Team and All-Conference in her Sophomore year. She became a two-time Captain for the LaSalle University Explorers, and received an All-American Honorable Mention in her Junior year.

Lauri graduated with an Accounting Degree and is currently employed as a Finance Director. She married her CB West classmate, Greg Halderson, and they live in Chalfont with their three children; Emily, Jake and Mya, all graduates of Central Bucks West.
