Coach Stan MacFarlane was optimistic as preparation for the Fall 1973 school year began for the Bux-Mont League soccer season. During a pre-season interview with *The Daily Intelligencer*, Coach MacFarlane humbly stated the above quote which later became history: Central Bucks West Soccer Team's inaugural *undefeated* Bux-Mont League Championship season.

The 1973 Varsity Soccer team was comprised primarily of experienced Seniors and several key Juniors and Sophomores. During the pre-season, the team was focused and their hard work produced the motto, *We Can Make It Happen!* The schedule opened with two non-league games between Springfield High School and Council Rock, both victories.

The regular season got underway with 5 straight victories, including 3 shutouts, before an important away matchup against a very skilled Central Bucks East team coached by Joas Gueiros. After scoring in the first four minutes of the match, their solid Defense produced a 1-0 victory.

In the following six games, the team remained undefeated with 5 Wins and 1 Tie which set up a rematch against Central Bucks East. Competing under the lights at War Memorial Field and four overtime periods, the game ended in a 3-3 Tie. West finished the season against North Penn with a 2-1 Win.

Their 14 wins; 0 losses and 2 ties carried them to the PIAA District One Playoffs. Matched against the Chester County League Champions, West Chester High School, the game was played under the lights at Upper Moreland High School Stadium.

The tough, fast paced, back and forth defense battle ended tied at 0-0. After four scoreless 15-minute overtime periods, PIAA playoff rules, the winner was determined by a corner kick count. Although West was still not outscored by any opponent all season, West Chester was declared the victor by a 4-2 corner kick advantage.

Although a tough loss, the Bucks total scoring for the season was 39-14 which included 9 shutouts.
