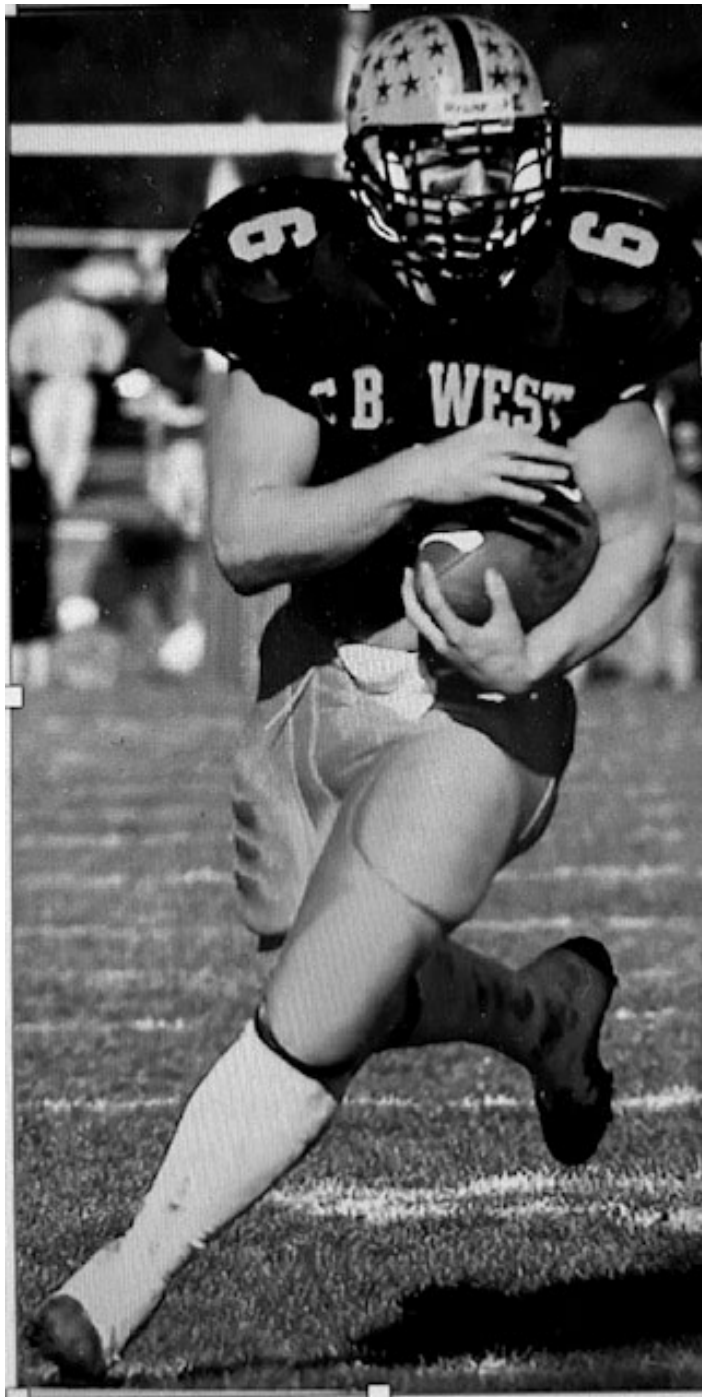

Central Bucks West

Philip DiGiacomo was a two-sport athlete earning six varsity letters in Football and Basketball at Central Bucks West. He was a member of the 1998 and 1999 Pennsylvania State Football Title Teams and in 2000, finished as the State Runner Up Team. In his Junior and Senior Years, Phil was a starting Guard on the Men's Basketball Team, leading the team to its first ever berth in the State Tournament.

Football

A Running Back on the varsity team for three years, his versatility allowed him to play multiple positions on Offense, Defense and Special Teams. Named Team Captain in his Senior Year, his total yards rushing over the three years was 2,170; 38 Receptions for 516 Yards; 529 Yards Passing; 44 TDs; 8 Interceptions on Defense. He was awarded AP 1st Team All State Running Back his Senior Year and was a 2000 Maxwell Award Recipient.

Basketball

As a member of the 1998, 1999, and 2000 varsity Basketball team, he earned three letters. During his Senior season in 2000, he helped lead the team to its first ever berth in the PA State Tournament. Always given the team's toughest Defense assignment, he often shut down the area's most dynamic offensive players. Other awards and selections include:

- 2000/2001 - 1st team in school history to make State Playoffs

Phil received a football scholarship to attend Villanova University, earning four varsity letters, along with being named team Offensive Player of the Year in 2004 and team Captain in 2004. Other notable awards include an Atlantic Ten Top 10 Finish in Receptions in 2003 and a 2002 National Semi Finalist Finish.

Phil graduated from Villanova in 2005 with a degree in Communications and accepted a Sales position with a local IT company where he met his future wife, Lindsey. He married in 2013, and they have three children—Phillip, Mo, and Madeline. Phil would like to thank everyone who helped him throughout his career, including his family, friends, coaches, and teammates he played with.
